Decision Tree Implementation

This project implemented decision trees for online scheduling, covering over 80% of appointment reasons. This allowed schedulers to book three times more new patient visits and enabled parents to schedule newborn appointments through MyChart. As a result, single call resolution increased from 58% to 82%, and there was a 50% cost savings in new patient scheduling by reducing the need for nurse involvement.





Integration & Harmony Across an Extended Rollout

Over a 12-month period, our team focused on harmonizing an **extended rollout by consolidating 6,000 reports**. We ensured smooth integration while accounting for unique requirements across the system. Transitioning to a Clinical Integrated Network






